

REFLECTION

Acts 9: 26–31 Psalm 21 (22) 1 Jo

1 John 3: 18–24 John 15: 1–8

The Gospel shows the amazing intimacy that Jesus offers through the wonderful image of the vine and branches. Having Jesus, the true vine, live within our hearts, we as his disciples, the branches, will bear fruit; cut off from Jesus, we can do nothing at all. Jesus reveals his Father as the vinedresser, tending to us with love, and sometimes pruning us so that we can produce more plentiful fruit. In the Second Reading, John reassures us that we have nothing to fear in God's loving presence. We get an indication of the fruit that Jesus speaks of when John tells us that our love needs 'not to be just words or mere talk, but something real and active.' We see an example of this in the First Reading, where Saul proves his love for Jesus by preaching about him to the community. During the week, I may like to ponder the relationship God longs to have with me, and the fruit he enables me to bear.
