



OCTOBER - MONTH OF THE ROSARY

The Rosary is a beautiful prayer, but for one reason or another many people never discover its beauty. October is a good time to re-evaluate the place the Rosary has in our lives and in our homes. It can feel like we are supposed to be doing so many things simultaneously – saying each Our Father and Hail Mary with due reverence, praying for our particular intentions, all the while trying to create vivid mental images of Christ and Our Lady in our mind's eye. If you find your mind wanders (and it will), just find a corner in the wandering that feels meaningful or significant to you and dedicate it to the decade you are reciting. To promote the place of the Rosary in our lives and in our homes we have a new statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary which people of the parish may sign up to host in their homes from Sunday to Sunday in October. If hosts wish to invite family or friends to join them for the Rosary in their homes, that would be greatly encouraged.
