

REFLECTION ON THE EASTER TRIDUUM

Holy Thursday: We rise above that loaf of bread and that flagon of wine to the bread of life and the blood of Christ. As often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes.

Good Friday: Behold the wood of the cross, on which our redeemer hung. Come, let us adore the saviour of the world.

Holy Saturday: If we enter into the silence of Holy Saturday, its bareness gives us no distractions. Holy Saturday takes us beyond grief and mourning into the deepest purification of our faith.

Easter Vigil: The eleventh century *Barberini Exultet Roll* shows illustrations of bees to accompany the Paschal vigil text. St. John Chrysostom wrote: *The bee is... honoured... not because it labours, but because it labours for others.* On this, your night of grace, O Holy Father, accept this candle, a solemn offering, the work of bees and of your servants' hands, an evening sacrifice of praise.

Easter Morning: On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. Mary leaves the tomb her hands full of light after touching things unseen.

Jesus Christ, our Redeemer,
