REFLECTION - PENTECOST SUNDAY

Acts 2:1-11 Psalm 103:1, 24,29-31, 34 Romans 8:8-17 John 14: 15-16, 23-26

The Resurrection of Jesus reaches its powerful climax with an outpouring of life, light and energy for his followers. After Jesus' crucifixion this small group of men and women were hiding. They were afraid and had lost all heart and hope. But through the gift of the Holy Spirit, they are filled with courage, enthusiasm and determination.
