REFLECTION

Wisdom 18 :6-9 Psalm 32 Hebrews 11:1-2,8-19 Luke 12:35-48

The Word of God this Sunday invites us on a faith journey and on pilgrimage. The second Reading refers to Abraham's call from God to leave his home and go to a foreign country. Abraham and his wife acted on God's invitation and set out on their pilgrimage. In the Gospel, during a moment of instruction, Jesus said to his disciples, 'Fear not, little flock, for it's your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.' He also instructed the disciples to be in a state of readiness. The Gospel suggests a few ways we can be ready: almsgiving which can take the form of giving time to people who need a listening ear, giving encouragement, and providing support and assistance to those in difficulty. Being ready can be about helping to create an environment or place where people can live safely and peacefully. Just as Abraham and his wife Sarah were pilgrims. We are all invited to be pilgrims. Being pilgrims does not mean we will always get things right but that we are always learning to trust in God and giving him the freedom to lead, guide and shape us.
