FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER Year C Good Shepherd Sunday & World Day of Prayer for Vocations 7th to 8th May 2022

REFLECTION

Acts 13:14, 43-52 Revelation 7:9, 14-17 John 10:27-30

On this 'Good Shepherd Sunday', Jesus speaks of himself as the Good Shepherd, who brings life, love and protection to those within his flock. In the First Reading as the people of Antioch reject the message of Paul and Barnabas, they turn their preaching to the pagans who readily hear and receive the message of eternal life offered by the Lord. In the book of Revelation we see Jesus as the Lamb, standing at the throne of God. We hear of the gifts of protection from hunger, thirst and sorrow which come to those who stand before God's throne. Jesus, the shepherd himself, speaks in the Gospel, reminding us of the blessings of care and protection his sheep are promised — both now, and in eternal life, with Jesus and the Father. This week, perhaps we can pray especially for the people of Ukraine and elsewhere in the world who, for whatever reason, may feel lost and without the protection of the shepherd they once knew. We continue to pray for peace across the world.
