

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER Year B

8 - 9 MAY 2021

REFLECTION

Acts 10: 25–26.34–35.44–48; Psalm 97 (98); 1 John 4: 7–10; John 15: 9–17

This Sunday's readings reveal that God's love is both profoundly faithful and utterly overwhelming. The First Reading shows a love that is also universal. The early disciples, at first limited in their mission, are now convinced that God's love embraces everyone. In the Second Reading St John says that God is love and acts lovingly when he sends his Son to reveal what true love means. God's outreach to the whole human race is what today's psalm sings of so joyfully. The Gospel goes on to speak even more deeply of God's love for us. It recalls Jesus's teaching about his loving relationship with his Father and of his desire to make this relationship both known and available. All are invited into that same intimate relationship! Perhaps this week, we may ask for the grace to let that teaching sink into our hearts and become a reality in the way we live. Help us, Lord, to respond to your friendship by being true friends to you through our loving relationships with our sisters and brothers. Amen.'
