




Year B REFLECTION 10 to 11 July 2021

Amos 7:12-15 Ephesians 1: 3-14 Mark 6:7-13

The unwilling Amos in the first reading was sent by God to tell the people to change their ways, to stop exploiting the poor and the weak, to bring sacrifices which were a real expression of homage to God. The climax of the sevenfold blessing with which the letter to the Ephesians begins is 'to bring everything under Christ as head.' All things are under Christ as head of creation, all nourishment for the creation and all guidance of creation. Jesus gives instructions for those on mission. They are to travel light for speed. They should wear sandals rather than go barefoot, also for speed and security. They are to rely for their provision on the welcome they receive, and if they are unwelcome they should not waste time on those who reject them. The challenge about being a Christian is that we never know when we will be called by the Lord to some special task, great or small - even if it is only welcoming the unexpected and tiresome visitor and remembering that he or she is in the place of Christ. All we need is an attitude to accept and respond to the demands laid on us.
