REFLECTION

Zephaniah 3:14-18

Responsorial: Isaiah 12:2-6

Philippians 4:4-7

Luke 3:10-18

This Third Sunday of Advent is called 'Gaudete Sunday' from the first word of the Entrance Antiphon in Latin: 'Gaudete!' – that is, 'Rejoice!' It is as though we can barely wait to celebrate the wonder and joy of Christmas, the coming of Christ Jesus into our world. We also see that God exults in us, his people, renewing us by his love. St Paul in the Second Reading encourages us to have confidence in God, to be happy in the Lord. We do not need to worry, because if there is anything we need, we can ask God for it. God will grant us a peace of heart and mind that is far greater than we can grasp or understand, keeping us safe in Christ Jesus. In the Gospel, the people come to John the Baptist to ask him, 'What must we do?' to prepare for the coming of the Christ. The answer is not the same for everyone, but all are asked to share with those who have less than themselves. So, what can we let go to share with those who have less.
