THE GOD WHO SPEAKS ON EASTER



On this Easter morning, we stand with the first believers at the empty tomb, full of wonder and awe at the enormity of what has taken place. In the First Reading (**Acts 10: 34, 37–43**), we hear a significant speech from Peter: God wants the salvation of all peoples. St Paul, in contrasting earthly and heavenly realities, urges the Colossians to set their gaze on heaven, where Christ is seated. Now we have been brought back to true life with Christ, we will share in his glory when he is revealed (**Col. 3: 1–4**). The Gospel records how Peter and his unnamed companion slowly come to realize that Jesus has risen from the dead. This disciple, 'the one Jesus loved', symbolises where all faithful Christians are invited to be: in a loving, intimate relationship with Christ (**John 20: 1–9**)

On this Easter Day, we may want to pray to recognise the dignity that belongs to us as Christians. We ask also for the grace we need to live out that dignity in practice, even when our daily lives have been unexpectedly upset in times of uncertainty and confusion.
