

REFLECTION

The word *mystery* refers to that which is hidden. When Jesus asks His disciples who they say He is, He is not simply being curious, but as good as asking, "What mystery do you say is hidden in me?" Peter's passion in this Gospel is at the fore. He acknowledges Jesus to be the Christ, but doesn't yet appreciate what this implies. To counteract the idea of the Messiah as a purely political and military figure, the Lord goes on to explain the suffering He must endure "quite openly". We also hear of the prophecy of this in our first reading today. But poor Peter misplaces his zeal and in remonstrating with Jesus receives one of the harshest rebukes in the New Testament – "Get behind me, Satan!" The Lord is not simply going to wipe away every opposition by divine might. Perhaps this is a lesson even we, as followers of Jesus in our time, can find difficult about walking God's path, for we naturally shrink from suffering. The final image offered in *taking up our own crosses* reminds us that we are sure to struggle one way or another, but Jesus is there united with us on the road to Calvary, as it were. The Good News consists in the resurrection hidden within it.


DATES FOR YOUR DIARY
