**Covid-19 (Coronavirus)** The Catholic Bishops' Conference of England & Wales recommends that all parish churches adopt the following measures to reduce the spread Covid-19:

- Have communion under one species and receive by hand only.
- Remove holy water stoups and fonts.
- Suspend the physical sign of peace.
- Stop use of shared missal and hymn books.
- Collection bags should not be passed around.
- All members of the congregation should wash or sanitise their hands as they come into church.
- Eucharistic ministers should sanitise their hands before and after distributing communion.
- Tea & coffee will not be served after Mass.
- If you have cold or flu symptoms we ask you to refrain from attending Liturgy, public events & the sacrament of reconciliation.
