

### SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER Year B

### REFLECTION

15 – 16 MAY 2021

#### Acts 1: 15–17.20–26; Psalm 102 (103);

1 John 4: 11–16; John 17: 11–19

The readings for this final Sunday of Easter remind us again of all the graces we have received through Jesus's death and resurrection, and the joy which comes from knowing just how much we are loved by God. In the First Reading, we hear of the election of Matthias, who takes the place of Judas, 'the one who chose to be lost.' Matthias joins the Apostles as one who was a witness to the Lord's Resurrection. The short Psalm extract reflects the enormity of God's love, and the boundless depths of his forgiveness. John's letter builds on that stating that God loved us first with such an infinite love and that we must love one another. In the Gospel, we hear Jesus himself asking his Father for everything he knows we need as he sends us out into the world. During the coming week, let's pray for the grace to recognise the gifts we have been given, and for a greater awareness of how we can use them in showing our love for others.
