REFLECTION

Amos 8: 4-7 Psalm 112 1 Timothy 2: 1-8 Luke 16:1-13

The steward in the Gospel story was a rogue and a rascal, but he had some good instincts. In his own perverse way, he was trying to make friends. When he was about to lose his good salary, he realized that what mattered most in life was not money but human relationships. The steward used money to make friends for himself. Jesus turned to his disciples and said, 'Use money, tainted as it is, to win you friends, and thus make sure that when it fails you, they will welcome you into the tents of eternity. The steward was only thinking about using his money to make earthly friends who would welcome him in their homes but Jesus was thinking of the importance of using money to make heavenly friends who would welcome us into their heavenly home. Jesus was saying if you have money invest it in people. When we use money in the service of others, especially in the service of those who are in greatest need, we will end up richer, in the deepest sense of that word.
