Isaiah 7: 10-14

Psalms 24:1-6

Romans 1:1-7

Matthew 1:18-24

Fear and doubts must have crossed the minds of both Mary and Joseph but their faith and trust in God allowed them to go on depending on each other. Their full obedience in faith brought about the wholehearted acceptance of the plan of God even though they did not understand what it all meant.
