

REFLECTION

Jeremiah 23:P1-16

Psalm 23:1-6

Ephesians 2:13-18 Mark 6: 30-34

As the Twelve return from their first missionary journey in today's Gospel, our readings continue to reflect on the authority and mission of the Church. Jeremiah promises that God will send a shepherd, a king and son of David, to gather the lost sheep and appoint for them new shepherds. As the crowd gather on the green grass in today's Gospel, they seem to sense that Jesus is the Lord, the good shepherd the king they've been waiting for. Jesus had said there were other sheep who did not belong to Israel's fold but who would hear His voice and be joined to the one flock of the one shepherd. In God's plan, the Church is to seek out first the lost sheep of the house of Israel and then bring all nations into the fold. Paul, too, in today's Epistle, sees the Church as a new creation, in which those nations who were once far off from God are joined as "one new person" with the children of Israel.

NEW RULES AT MASS FROM MONDAY 19th JULY

Given the rising infection rate, we will continue to do what we can to limit the spread of the virus amongst those who have not yet been vaccinated (everyone under the age of 17) and those for whom vaccination has not triggered an adequate immune response.

Therefore, we will keep all our current Covid safety measures in place. We thank you for continuing to do the following:

- · wearing masks whilst inside church
- disinfecting hands upon arrival & departure
- maintaining at least 1m social distance
- remaining seated until a steward indicates it is safe to leave.

In addition, doors will be kept open during Mass for ventilation and stewards will continue to clean all used seats after Mass.
