REFLECTION: SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Only two and half weeks have passed since New Year's Day with its tradition of making resolutions. Research reveals that by the end of January around 40% of those who make resolutions will already have broken them. While we may look at this figure as a proof of the futility of trying to turn over a new leaf, the second reading from St Paul's letter to the Corinthians offers another perspective. St Paul writes a letter to the community of Corinth and, therefore, to us urging us to refrain from self- condemnation, but appealing to us for a new call to conversion.
