REFLECTION

Isaiah 66: 18-21 Psalm 116 Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13 Luke 13:22-30 'Sir, will there be only a few saved?' Jesus doesn't answer this question put to Him in today's Gospel for a good reason. What benefit is there to indulging in speculating on how many will be saved? Before the Master closes the door, trying our best now is far more urgent than undue speculation. Jesus is the only way to salvation. It is important to know that He is the "narrow gate," by which all must travel to enter the kingdom of the Father. In Jesus, God has come, as He promises in this week's First Reading, to gather nations of every language, to reveal to them His glory. Eating & drinking with them, teaching in their streets, Jesus in the Gospel is slowly making His way to Jerusalem. In God's plan, the kingdom was proclaimed first to the Israelites & last to the Gentiles, who in the Church have come from the earth's four corners to make up the new people of God. Many, however, will lose their place at the heavenly table, Jesus warns. Refusing to accept His narrow way they will weaken, rendering themselves unknown to the Father.
