# SOLEMNITY OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

Daniel 7:13-14

Psalm 92 (93)

Apocalypse 1:5-8



John 18: 33-37

The Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, brings the Church's year to a close, and calls us to celebrate again Jesus's victory over suffering and death. As servants, we offer all that we are, and invite him to reign within our hearts, so that we can play our part in bringing God's truth, love, justice and peace to the world. The First Reading describes Daniel's vision of a 'son of man' coming on the clouds of heaven to be crowned King, with everlasting sovereignty, ruling over an empire that will never be destroyed. In the Second Reading, Jesus is described as coming on the clouds and as ruler of the kings of the earth. In the Gospel, we witness the scene in which Pilate asks Jesus the question, 'Are you the King of the Jews?' In his reply, Jesus speaks of a kingdom in which those who seek the truth listen to his voice and follow his ways. This week, we ask God for the grace to open our hearts and minds to the needs of those who do not yet know his voice.
