

21 - 22 August 2021

REFLECTION

Joshua 24: 1-2, 15-18 Psalm 34: 2-3, 16-23 Ephesians 5: 21-32 John 6: 60-69

This Sunday's liturgy is centred on choice. Joshua gathers the chosen people at Shechem This is the place where God first appeared to their father Abraham promising to make his descendants a great nation in a new land. Joshua issues a blunt challenge: either renew their covenant with God or serve the alien gods of the surrounding nations. The Twelve Apostles in today's Gospel are asked to make a choice—either to believe and accept the New Covenant He offers in His Body and Blood or return to their former ways of life. We too are being asked today to decide whom we will serve. Our Lord has promised us a new homeland and eternal life, offering us bread from heaven to strengthen us on our journey. He has told us that unless we eat His Flesh and drink His Blood, we will have no life in us. Let us renew our covenant today, approaching the altar with confidence that, as we sing in today's Psalm, the Lord will redeem the lives of His servants.
