


REFLECTION

Jonah 3: 1–5,10 1 Corinthians 7: 29–31 Mark 1: 14–20

The Third Sunday in Ordinary Time marks the 'Sunday of the Word of God', instituted by Pope Francis in 2019 as an annual celebration of the gift of Scripture. It encourages us to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures. The readings for this Sunday call us to follow the Lord's ways. This involves some change of priorities and direction for us as we seek to move towards the kingdom of God. In the First Reading, the people of Nineveh renounce their evil ways in response to Jonah preaching the word of God. The Second Reading encourages us to live in a way guided by the love of Christ. We are called to live in open freedom and detachment – it is who we are, not what we have, that counts. In the Gospel we hear of Jesus beginning his ministry by finding and inviting the first disciples to leave their work as fishermen and follow him for greater things. Perhaps during this coming week, we can pray for the grace to be open to any change the Lord asks us to make, so that we can respond better to his call and be ready to go wherever he is asking us to.
