

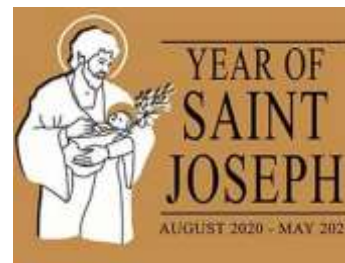

### REFLECTION

**Acts 4: 8–12**

**Psalm 117 (118)**

**1 John 3: 1–2**

**John 10: 11–18**

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is World Day of Prayer for Vocations. We hear Our Lord's wish that 'They too will listen to my voice ...' By virtue of our baptism, we are being called to share the joys of heaven so that so that the humble flock may reach where the brave Shepherd has gone before. On this Vocation's Sunday the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd is used to draw out the depth of the love that God has for his people. Jesus lays down his life for us so that we might truly live. By describing himself in this way, Jesus is describing the close, intimate relationship we are each called to have with the living Lord and with one another. As we pray this week, let us keep in mind all those preparing for marriage, Holy Orders and Religious Life. May they have the grace to truly listen with open and accepting hearts to what they aspire.
