### REFLECTION

**Isaiah 2:1-5**

**Psalm 122:1-98**

**Romans 13:11-14**

**Matthew 24:37-44**

Be watchful! Stay awake! Be prepared! Be ready! These are key instructions for us as we prepare for the coming of Christ. Why all these statements? It is because we can become so immersed in our daily activities that we forget about life after death. It means that we need to be prepared and stand ready for we do not know when the day will come when we will be called home. In the second reading, Paul reminds us that “**the time**” has come; you must wake up now, our salvation is even nearer. We are exhorted to be vigilant, to pray at all times for the strength to survive all that is going to happen and to stand with confidence when the time comes to meet our Lord. Let our concern not be with worldly affairs that distract us from remembering that there is a God. Let us live each day anticipating that whenever His call comes, we are ready. What is crucial is that we do not postpone our repentance and that are set to be ready for Him, spiritually and morally, when He comes.
