#### REFLECTION

Zeph 2:3; 3:12-13 Ps 146: 6-10 I Cor 1: 26-31 Matt 5: 1-12

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus goes to the mountain to proclaim a new law—the law of His Kingdom. Through the wisdom that he speaks, Jesus bestows the Father's blessings upon "the poor in spirit." God has chosen to bless the weak and lowly, those foolish and despised in the eyes of the world as Paul says in the letter to the Corinthians. The poor in spirit are those who know that nothing they do can merit God's mercy and grace. These are the humble remnant in today's First Reading. The Beatitudes reveal the divine path and purpose for our lives. We should all strive for these virtues: to be poor in spirit; meek and clean of heart; merciful and makers of peace; seekers of the righteousness that comes from living by the law of the Kingdom. The path the Lord sets before us today is one of trials and persecution. But He promises comfort in our mourning and a great reward. And, as we sing in today's Psalm, its blessings are for those whose hope is in the Lord.
