

REFLECTION

Today we trace the full development of God's intention for the Law. We hear in the book of Deuteronomy how close this brings the people of Israel to the Lord God – it is a testimony of love unknown to other races. Saint James, as recorded in Paul's letter to the Galatians, continued to value the Jewish history and way of life, and so, employs imagery from nature and the corresponding rituals to relate to his readers. The notion of the initial generation of believers being "a sort of first-fruits" refers to the first sheaf of spring wheat that was cut from the field and offered to God in their day. Now Christ has become the perfect offering acceptable to God, fulfilling every prior condition of the Law. What Mark the Evangelist wishes to communicate is just how easy observing even a multitude of legal requirements is instead of taking its purpose to heart. Religion consists not in piety but in putting one's beliefs into action so that our outward expression is harmonised with our inner world. This can be a good practice to recall when going to confession. Whatever our actions, they spring from the heart, which day by day we strive to open as best we can to God and others. This is the new law – the law of love, from which all else flows.
