Ezekiel 18:25-28: People in Ezekiel's time strongly blamed the Lord for their situation in exile. As a way forward Ezekiel invites them to take personal responsibility for 'sin' and to do what was right and just. Q: *Is there an attitude of 'blame' in your life rather than taking personal 'responsibility'? Blame leads to death. Personal responsibility leads to life.*

Philippians 2:1-11: St Paul invites disciples to have the one essential attitude that will maintain unity: humility. Tis entails giving up an attitude of competition, of having special rights or power. Q: Can you think of a situation in which being 'humble' would have saved a meeting, an argument or relationship? How could you become 'humbler'?

Matthew 21:28-32 Two sons in the Gospel give responses that hurt the father as he asks them to go and work in the vineyard. No one here is perfect. The in-thing for Jewish people was to show 'honour'. The son who said **'Yes, sir'** was honourable in front of the Father but it was soon revealed that it was an empty and meaningless honour. Honour is shown ultimately in real obedience. Q: What will it mean for you to 'walk the talk' in obedience this week? Consider writing it down
