ADVENT REFLECTION

Advent looks back to the first coming of Christ in the stable at Bethlehem. We look back in order to look forward to the second coming on the clouds of glory. Thus Christmas is not sterile memorial of a thing past and gone, but effectual preparation for what is to come. The great symbol of Advent is the Advent wreath through which we witness the increase of light. Candles are lit in ever greater number in growing expectation of the End. Advent is an extended meditation on the mystery of time. We look back to the moment of the incarnation, in order to see the meaning of the flow of the events of human history towards their fulfilment. Assessing the importance of human events in this light gives hope even in the face of disaster and the failures of our politicking which are thereby set in their proper perspective.
