Reflection on the Sacrament of Baptism

We Catholics hold that the celebration of this sacrament is the gateway to spiritual life. Through baptism one becomes a member of the Church. Claimed by Christ in baptism, each member shares in the priesthood of all believers. Thus, by baptism we belong to one another, a community whose members pour out their lives in service to one another, each using their unique gifts and abilities to build up the whole (CCC 1268 – 69). While faith and baptism are closely linked, faith is required as evidence before one can go into the life-giving waters. The reasoning behind the baptism of infants is that the faith of the parents is the evidence before the baptism of an infant. Every individual who is baptized, regardless of age, is called to grow in maturity and develop the practice of the faith with the help of the entire household of the faithful (CCC 1253). Finally, the Catholic Church understands baptism as our incorporation into Christ's mission. Believers step forth from the baptismal font, washed, reborn and reinvigorated so that they might proclaim the good news of salvation by their words and deeds in every circumstance of life that they will meet. 
