#### **NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

1 Kings 19:9, 11-13 Psalm 84 Romans 9:1-5Matthew 14: 22-33

The mountain of Horeb in the First Reading was another term for the famous Mt Sinai where Moses met face to face with God. Unlike Moses, Elijah is being chased. He challenged the Queen for putting statues of Baal in the temple, killed 400 Baal prophets and is running frightened in the desert. He seeks God. Where do you go to seek God? Have you had an experience of doing something for God and it meets resistance? In St Paul's letter to the Romans, chapters 9-11 reflect a great sadness that the Jewish people have not recognised and believed in Jesus. Have you experienced sorrow and anguish for someone who has not believed in Jesus or has left their Christian faith? Consider placing them before God in prayer. A boat tossed about in the sea has always been an early symbol of the Church. Throughout history many storms have caused the Church to cry out to Jesus for help. What forces torture you and the church today? What could you pray for God to 'save' the Church from today? Save you from today?

Maryvale Institute has announced the continuation of the Bachelor of Divinity (BDiv) and Licence Programmes, allowing them to begin recruiting new students immediately. The Maryvale Higher Institute of Religious Sciences (HIRS) is the only ecclesial institute of this kind in the Englishspeaking world. It operates both the B.Div and Licence Programmes. The Ecclesiastical BDiv is a five-year parttime, collaborative-learning degree programme in Catholic theology providing a comprehensive exposition and analysis of Christian doctrine based on the study of the sacred Scriptures, the works of the Fathers and Doctors of the Church, and the documents of the Magisterium. The Licence in Divinity: Pathway in Catechetical Sciences is another qualification of the Holy See, distinct from an STL. It is a three-year, part-time, programme aimed at those in leadership positions in catechetics and in other positions of responsibility.
