### Second Sunday of Ordinary Time - Year B 13th – 14<sup>th</sup> January 2024 - Parish Mass Book Page 127

1 SAMUEL 3:3b-10, 19 John 1: 35-42

We begin the season of Ordinary Time with classic vocation narratives. The young Samuel asleep in the temple, was awakened by hearing his name being called. He went to Eli three times, thinking that the priest was summoning him. Realizing that Samuel was hearing God's voice, Eli told the young man to put himself at God's service by saying "Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening." The culmination of the story is Samuel's willingness to listen to God's voice. In biblical terms, the idea of listening is equivalent to obedience. The Gospel invites us to share the adventure of vocation with two of John the Baptist's disciples. When John the Baptist pointed to Jesus saying, "Look, there is the Lamb of God," they then tried to catch up with Jesus as he walked along. At that point Jesus turned to them and asked the most important question of their life: "What are you looking for?" The disciple's question, "Where do you live?" was a way of saying, "We want to know more." As people baptized and thus consecrated to God, we also must want to know more.

WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY 2024: 18th -25th January "You shall love the Lord your God ...and your neighbour as yourself..." An ecumenical team from Burkina Faso facilitated by the local Chemin Neuf Community has been the convener for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2024 drafting group. The World Council of Churches (WCC) and the Vatican have now published the material in several languages. The reflections explore how we find our common identity in the experience of God's love. The specific context of Burkina Faso reflects the need to place love at the centre of the quest for peace and reconciliation. The introduction also notes that Christian communities in Burkina Faso try to live the call to love through mutual hospitality.
