### REFLECTION ON THE EASTER TRIDUUM

The Latin word *Triduum* means a period of three days. These are the three most solemn days of the liturgical year depicting the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. On Holy Thursday, Jesus instituted the Eucharist and the ministerial priesthood. Christians remember that Jesus Christ gave his body and blood to them as a remedy for immortality. With the humble and expressive gesture of the washing of the feet, the Lord Jesus concretely proclaimed the primacy of love. Good Friday is a day to commemorate the Passion, Cross, and death of Jesus Christ. It's a day of fasting. The liturgy of Good Friday consists of three parts: the liturgy of the Word, the veneration of the Cross and the reception of the Holy Communion. Holy Saturday is marked by profound silence, meditation. It is a day to celebrate forgiveness and reconciliation. At the heart of the night, the Paschal candle, the symbol of Jesus Christ in glory, is lit from the new fire. The Priest carries the Paschal candle, lifting it three different times and chanting: "Christ our Light". Let us participate in the Easter Triduum, preparing our hearts to celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.
