### 'FORGIVENESS'

**Ecclesiasticus 27:30-28.7:** The Book of Sirach (Ecclesiasticus) was also known as the **'Church Book.'** It was used to instruct new candidates for Baptism with all its wisdom lessons for living. Today, *'forgiveness'* is the theme. Breaking the chain of hurt, unforgiveness and violence is extremely difficult. **Q:** Are you 'hugging tightly' any anger or resentment?

Romans 14:7-9: Tensions existed between Jews who kept all their 'laws' and 'customs' faithfully, and Gentiles who did not feel the obligation of the 'laws' and 'customs' of the Jews. *Q: Do you identify with a particular 'group' within the Church? Q: Do you create barriers and ill feeling toward 'others' who are not of 'your group'?* Paul reminds us we are not individuals or 'groups' but one.

Matthew 18:21-35: Peter asks Jesus precisely how generous one has to be towards someone who has wronged them. Rabbis taught three times. Peter suggests a large and generous amount using the perfect number 7. Jesus pronounces an uncountable amount: 77 (double perfection!). Justice and its strict legal prescription is to be overwhelmed by Mercy and God's love. *Q: Do you have a struggle with acceptance of forgiveness or the giving of it?* You may as well consider what you need to do. #### Evangelii Gaudium Sunday: 17 September 2023

Evangelii Gaudium: Preparing for the Jubilee Year in Faith and Prayer. This Sunday calls us to be joyous in proclaiming our faith. "Evangelii Gaudium" is Latin for "Joy of the Gospel". The day supports the work carried out by the Mission Directorate on behalf of the Bishops' Conference. A key focus of work for the next few years is responding to Pope Francis' calling of a Jubilee Year in 2025 with the theme *Pilgrims of Hope*. The Holy Father has invited the whole Church to prepare for the Jubilee in the two years prior through:

Reflecting on the four Constitutions of the Second Vatican Council in 2023.

Deepening our prayer life, with a special focus on the Lord's Prayer, in 2024.
