


Overview of the Gospel: In the discourse we hear today, Jesus admits others to share both his mission and his powers, and commissions them to proclaim on a scale wider than he could reach personally. Jesus chose ordinary people to do extraordinary work. They were non-professionals, had no wealth or privileged position. They were chosen from the common people who did ordinary things, had no special education, and no social advantages. When the Lord calls us to serve, we must not think we have nothing or very little to offer. Do you believe that God wants to work in and through you for his glory? The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that all of the Christian faithful— not just priests and religious—have an active apostolic role to in the work and ministry of the Church (CCC §§ 863-865). What role or roles in the apostolate am I currently filling? If I am not filling a role, how can I pray and discern that God show me what that might be?
