REFLECTION

On the fiftieth day after Jesus' Resurrection, ten days after His Ascension, the disciples experienced something beyond their imagination. From the sky came a noise like a strong driving wind. It filled the room they were in. Tongues, as of fire, fell upon all gathered, and they were given the gift of tongues, which enabled them to speak in different languages to the diverse groups of people in Jerusalem. After receiving the Holy Spirit, the disciples went out into the community of Jerusalem and began to boldly proclaim the Gospel to all. As we celebrate the great Solemnity of Pentecost, call on the Holy Spirit in your life. Too often we receive Baptism and Confirmation with a closed mind and heart. We fail to allow the Holy Spirit to become fully active in our lives. Pray to the Holy Spirit and open yourself more fully to all that God wishes to bestow upon you so that you will become holy and a more active member of His Body, the Church. **Prayer:** 'Holy Spirit, come to me and bestow upon me Your seven-fold gifts, so that I can grow closer to Christ Jesus and act more faithfully as a member of His Body.'

COMING SOON: (THE NEW LECTIONARY) The new Lectionary will use the English Standard Version Catholic Edition of the Bible and the Abbey Psalter. The changes are intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, biblical scholarship, and to provide a text for use in liturgical setting that is more proclaimable and, where appropriate, more inclusive. It will become mandatory for use in all Catholic parishes and Mass centred in England and Wales and in Scotland from Advent 2024. We shall need to have the following editions for our parish: The Ambo Edition which comes in Four volumes for the lectern, the study version which will is portable for use in domestic, house or school Mass settings and the book of Gospels. Stickers to inscribe names of those who donate the cost of the new liturgical books will be available.
