Genesis 22:1-2, 9-13, 15-18 Romans 8:31-34 Mark 9:2-10Our Lenten season with the account of Satan testing Jesus in the wilderness last Sunday. This Sunday, we continue with another tale of testing where we hear how God tested Abraham. He told Abraham to build an altar and to offer up his "beloved son," Isaac, as a sacrifice on a mountain. There is a difference between Satan tempting us and God testing us. Satan tempts us to sin to separate us from our relationship with God and to destroy us while God tests us not strengthen our faith. In the Gospel, God calls Jesus His "beloved Son" on the mountain of the Transfiguration. In much same way Isaac was Abraham's "beloved son". The difference is that God spared Abraham's beloved son, but He did not spare His "beloved Son," who died as a sacrifice on the altar of the Cross for the sins of humanity. Abraham's story of testing and faith in offering his beloved son Isaac on an altar foreshadows how God, like Abraham, did not withhold His beloved Son from the altar of the Cross. Jesus died for all the beloved sons and daughters in the human family as a sign of God's love for the world.

NOTIFICATION OF CHANGES IN MASS TIMES: Following the Mass time survey we had to change the Sunday Mass Times: Fr Naz is very grateful for the responses he received concerning the timing of Masses on Sundays that might allow one priest to serve both St Joseph's, Upton and St Joseph's, Malvern. He is particularly thankful for the understanding that has been shown of his predicament: to serve both parishes he must allow enough time to offer the Mass with proper reverence in both localities and also allow time for him to meet with parishioners after the Masses and to travel between the two. The Sunday Mass times will, therefore, change on the 7th April, that is the Sunday after Easter, to 9am at Upton and 11am at Malvern; and will follow that pattern thereafter. These times will inevitably cause a degree of inconvenience but are the times most people opted for. Fr Naz trusts that with tolerance and goodwill we shall adapt to the change. Thank you.
