REFLECTION
Jeremiah 20: 10-13 Psalm 68 Romans

Romans 5:12-15 Matthew 10: 26-33

Jesus said, "Do not be afraid". The times we live in have an air of instability, and everyone feels the sense of upheaval and unpredictability. We fear infections from deadly viruses, we fear toxic substances in the food chain; we fear the destruction of the environment; we fear unsound teachings both in the Church and in our catholic schools, let alone in the public schools. Unless those fears become neurotic or psychic, they are healthy fears. They protect us from harm. Fear is therefore perfectly understandable. Something similar is very much echoed the our lives of practicing Catholics. From a "church" point of view, we moan about dwindling attendance at Masses, and we wonder who will be in church in the coming years. We also who will preside at the Lord's Supper. From a personal point of view, familiar faith affirmations seem no longer as tenable as they used to be. And yet, at the centre of the faith project stands not my condition or even my faith, but all that God did for us Jesus' death and resurrection. As Paul exclaims who will (or can) separate us from the love of God in Christ?
