REFLECTION

Amos 6:1, 4-7 Psalm 145 1 Timothy 6:11-16 Luke 16:19-31

Our society & the wider world are places of extremes. We have the very wealthy and the desperately poor. This Sunday's gospel puts the abundance of the rich man and the poverty of Lazarus. The rich and powerful are visited with woe and exile in today's Liturgy—not for their wealth but for their refusal to share it, not for their power but their indifference to the suffering at their door. In this world, the rich and powerful make a name for themselves and dine sumptuously, while the poor remain anonymous, and refused an invitation to their feasts. But notice that the Lord today knows Lazarus by name, while the rich man has no name. Every day, in countless small ways, we are asked to look beyond our own needs to see the needs of others. It is said that for evil to thrive all that is needed is that good people do nothing. This week, let us look beyond our needs and see where we can help another person and make a difference.
