

Jesus says something quite comforting when he says he is the vine, and we are the branches. But then, he quickly suggests that God is like a gardener who prunes us so that we will bear more fruit. That doesn't sound fully nice considering that pruning is a violent action. Pruning involves taking a knife, a clipper, or a saw to a plant, sometimes cutting it down without killing it, so that the plant may grow to greater splendour. This is an uncomfortable analogy because pruning is painful. The benefit here of course is to get rid of dead or diseased branches and so promote the health of the entire plant. A gardener may prune a plant just to improve that plant's appearance. But again, pruning can help protect the wellbeing of other plants or even people, if there is a safety or property concern. The whole point of pruning is that objectively speaking, God sure seems to allow evil. There is nothing fun about being pruned but there comes a time when we will be grateful for the skilful hands of the master Gardener!

Any suspicious or fraudulent communications must directly be communicated to the parish office and then we would forward it to the diocesan IT Department for further investigation.
