ALL SAINTS DAY: CATHOLIC PRACTICE

The saints are very important to the life of the Church and to the Catholic people. From the Apostles' Creed, we claim that 'we believe in the communion of saints'. This does not mean that the saints are lined up to receive Holy Communion from the Lord in heaven! Communion here means fellowship or sharing in the gifts given by God to those whom God has chosen. All who belong to Christ are saints; all these have been transformed from sin to grace by the power of the Holy Spirit. We have fellowship with the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God and our mother. Mary holds priority of place among all the saints. She was the first to believe in the Son of God, the first to hope for salvation through Jesus Christ, the first to love him and to love his disciples because of him. Our own patron saints, those whose names we bear and those we have chosen to be our special intercessors before the throne of God, are our friends and a sign of what we hope to be by God's mercy and love.
