REFLECTION

Year A

Acts 2:14a, 36-41Psalm 231 Peter 2:20b-25John 10:1-10The readings this Sunday invite us to reflect on the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd who cares for his flock.
This image demonstrates that Jesus is intimately involved in our lives, and that he knows us and loves us individually.
It also reminds us that we are called to follow him, and to trust in his guidance and protection. As we reflect on this
image of the Good Shepherd, we are invited to consider the quality of our own relationship with Jesus. Do we
recognize his voice and follow him? Do we trust in his care and protection, even in the face of difficulty or uncertainty?
Are we willing to let him guide us on the path he has set for us? The Good Shepherd offers us protection from those
who would lead us astray. We are also reminded that we are not alone in our journey. We are part of a larger
community of believers, the Church, which is led and guided by Christ himself. As members of this community, we are
called to support and care for one another, just as the Good Shepherd cares for his sheep.
