Central idea: The prudence of choosing Christ.

The Lord says he will give Solomon anything he asks for. Instead of asking for a long life, or riches, or any of the other valuable things, Solomon asks for prudence so he can govern Israel. He goes for practical wisdom, the cardinal virtue of prudence. The kingdom of God, or Christ himself, is of unsurpassed value. The most prudent thing anyone can do who gets a glimpse of it is to put it first in one's life, like the person who finds the treasure buried in the field or the jeweller who finds a pearl of great price.

Becoming more prudent: Prudence is necessary for us to be good citizens of this earth and beyond. We are faced with choices every day and from time to time with very big decisions.


